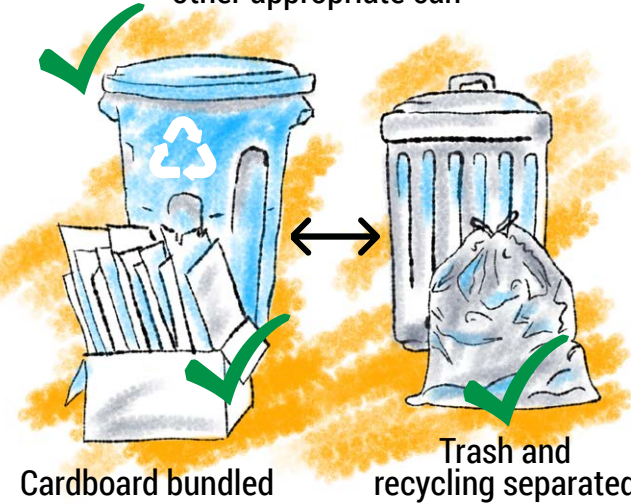

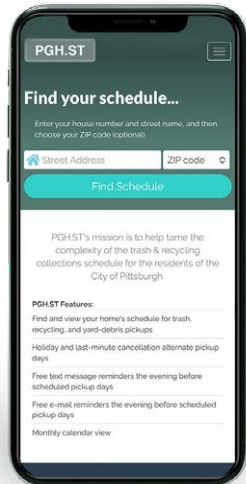

When is Your Collection Day?

Type 'PGH.ST' into any internet browser and search by address

Curbside Yard Debris Collection

April 20th and November 2nd

ACCEPTED ITEMS:

- Leaves
- Grass
- Plants
- Tree Trimmings
- Branches
- Shrubs

Debris must be placed in a paper bag (no plastic bags are accepted)

Branches should be bundled and tied, and no bigger than 4 inches in diameter and lengths not more than 5 feet long

Recycling is collected every other week. Cardboard and other recyclable materials will only be accepted on recycling week.

Pittsburgh Goes Plastic Bag Free!



We'd like to remind you that Pittsburgh has banned plastic bags and they will become increasingly scarce in our community.

When recycling, please place recyclables loosely in the recycling bin at the curb, without bagging them in plastic grocery bags. Overflow recyclables should be placed loosely in another bin clearly marked for recycling.

Thanks for supporting the city's efforts to go plastic free in stores and at the curb!

What goes inside my blue bin for curbside collection in Pittsburgh?



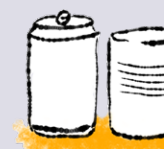
PLASTIC CONTAINERS
 Bottles, jugs & jars only. Remove lids and caps.



CARDBOARD
 Flatten, bundle & place in your bin, or another box.



GLASS
 Bottles, jugs & jars. Remove lids and caps.



METAL CONTAINERS
 Empty aluminum, aerosol, & steel cans. Leave labels on, discard lids, or leave attached to can.



MIXED PAPER
 Office, newspaper, junk mail, magazines, soft/hardback books, and paperboard.

Keep Our Environmental Services Workers Safe!

- Please slow down and look for city workers before attempting to pass any truck.
- Secure needles and syringes in hard plastic container with a tight fitting lid, labeled "medical waste" and place in the trash.
- Maintain clear access from the street to the items you have placed at the curb for collection with a clear separation between trash and recycling.
- Snow must be removed from sidewalks within 24 hours after each snowfall. Please do not plow snow, sleet, or ice against garbage receptacles.

- Household Hazardous Waste Drop Off (by appt. only)

Curbside Regulations

- All items for pickup must be set out no earlier than 6:00 p.m. on the night before collection and no later than 6:00 a.m. the day of collection.
- All cans set out for collection must not exceed 35 gallons in size and must be removed from the curb after collection on your pickup day (City code 619).
- Each dwelling may only set out two bulk items per week. Carpeting and fencing must be tied and bundled not to exceed 35 lbs or 5 ft in length.
- Tires, electronics, and household hazardous waste including liquids and flammables are prohibited from curbside disposal but are accepted at various drop off locations in the city.
- Automotive parts and large amounts of construction and demolition waste are prohibited from curbside collection.
